



CONSTABLE JOHN ATKINSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION

The Constable John Atkinson Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in memory of Constable John Atkinson to honour his service and the ultimate sacrifice he made while protecting the citizens of Windsor and Essex County. In 2006, Shelley Atkinson created the Constable John Atkinson Fund at the WindsorEssex Community Foundation in order to keep John's memory alive. A decade later, Shelley designated the fund to aid students pursuing a career in Law Enforcement. Helping the next generation of law enforcers reach their potential is John's legacy.

To be eligible for the scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- Open to all students (new and returning) pursuing education in a law enforcement program
- Must be pursuing post-secondary education in a law enforcement program; proof of enrollment is required.
- Must demonstrate evidence of community involvement.

- Why you have chosen this post-secondary course and why you are interested in pursuing a career in the Law Enforcement Field;
- How will this scholarship help you? What are some of the barriers to entry into Law Enforcement that you have experienced?
