



HARDING ELECTRIC BURSARY FUND FOR APPRENTICES IN SKILLED TRADE PROGRAMS

The Harding Electric Bursary Fund for Apprentices in Skilled Trade Programs has been established in memory of Morris Harding and Ruth Henderson-Harding. This bursary is to be awarded to secondary school students who are graduating from a secondary school operated by the Greater Essex County District School Board or its successor. It is stipulated that the bursary be awarded to students who will be attending a program at a community college (or equivalent) in the province of Ontario and will be taking a program to become a qualified **Skilled Trades** person.

Graduating students must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for a bursary:

- The student will be attending a program at a community college (or equivalent) in the province of Ontario and will be taking a program to become a qualified skilled trades person.
- The student must demonstrate financial need.
- The student must have maintained a good academic standing.
- Applicants are required to submit an official transcript from the secondary school. Please include the latest mid-term evaluation.
