To be eligible for the scholarship, (General eligibility applies to all students)

- Academic Status: Applicants must be currently enrolled in, or accepted to, a recognized college or university in Canada.
- Financial Need: Applicants must demonstrate financial need or barriers that may limit access to post-secondary education.
- Academic Commitment: Applicants must show satisfactory academic progress and a clear commitment to completing their program of study.
- Community Engagement: Applicants must demonstrate involvement in community service, leadership, work, or extracurricular activities.
- Field of Study: enrolled in studies or training in a construction-related field, including skilled trades, construction management, civil engineering, urban design, or architecture.
- Environmental Commitment: Demonstrate a focus in environmentally responsible and sustainable building practices, energy efficiency, or green construction innovation.
