



HOCKTOBERFEST LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Hocktoberfest Legacy Scholarship Fund was established to provide a yearly scholarship to a female hockey player who is entering post-secondary school or currently enrolled in a post-secondary program and playing in the Hocktoberfest Female Hockey Tournament. *If the tournament ceases to operate then any female hockey player is eligible for the scholarship.*

To be eligible for the scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- Must have reached secondary school graduating status and be pursuing a post-secondary education or be enrolled in a post-secondary program.
- **Proof of enrollment is required.**
- Must be a female hockey player
- Must be taking part in this year's Hocktoberfest Female Hockey Tournament
- Must have an overall good grade average
- Must demonstrate evidence of community involvement.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY & DISBURSEMENT GUIDELINES

In accordance with Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) regulations, the following rules apply to all scholarship awards:

Eligible Institutions Only

Scholarships can only be awarded to Canadian post-secondary institutions registered with the CRA. This means that private career colleges and U.S.-based schools are not eligible to receive scholarship funds. Students planning to attend these institutions will unfortunately not be eligible for scholarship funding.
